## SENECA ART AND CULTURE CENTER

## **TOUR / PROGRAM REQUEST FORM**

Ganondagan State Historic Site is the only New York State site dedicated to Native peoples and can be considered as the ancestral homeland to the Seneca people. Ganondagan was the largest thriving Seneca community in the mid-17th century, with a population of roughly 4,000 people.

Today, Ganondagan and the Seneca Art and Culture Center serves as an educational institution, sharing the history, lifestyle, culture, and art of the Senecas and the Haudenosaunee as a whole. The mission of Ganondagan is that it continues to be the Town of Peace, and that the Haudenosaunee are still here, living and thriving today.

#### GENERAL PROGRAMMING INFORMATION

- Programs must be requested at least two weeks in advance.
- Group size must be a minimum of 10 attendees up to a maximum of 75 attendees.
- On Site Tours are available 10am-12pm and 1pm-3pm Wednesdays through Saturdays.
- Outreach Programs or Virtual Programs are available between 10am and 4pm Wednesdays through Saturdays.
- Spring/Summer Season (March-July) Reservations begin January 2.
- Fall/Winter Season (August-December) Reservations begin May 1.
- All reservations, either on site or off site, must include a signed NYS Tour Agreement.
- A 50% deposit OR a Purchase Order, payable to Ganondagan State Historic Site, must be provided to secure
  the program date and time, and can be accepted after a signed NYS Tour Agreement has been received.
